

Residuary Gift

I give free of inheritance tax (x %) of the residue of my estate to the Family Forge whose registered Office is The Retreat, Cobbs Brow Lane, Newburgh WN8 7ND (Registered Charity No. 1161900), for its charitable purposes and declare that the receipt of an authorised official for the time being shall be a good discharge to my executors.(this is legal terminology which gives the person administering your estate confirmation that your gift has gone to the correct destination).

Pecuniary Gift

I give free of Inheritance Tax the sum of £x to the Family Forge whose registered office is situated at The Retreat, Cobbs Brow Lane, Newburgh WN8 7ND (registered Charity No.1161900), for its charitable purposes and declare that the receipt of an authorised official for the time being shall be a good discharge to my executors.

Tax Benefits

Leaving a legacy to a charity can benefit your estate and enable you to leave more money to your family. It can also reduce the amount of Inheritance Tax you have to pay especially if you leave at least 10% of your assets to charity. Your solicitor will be able to advise you on this.

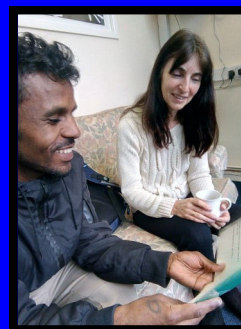

The Family Forge is a registered charity based in Lancashire. It exists to strengthen family life. It currently works with the regions' asylum seeking and refugee community. This group forms the area's newest residents. Residents who face multiple barriers to prosperity and opportunity.

This group includes people from many nationalities, cultures and religions. It includes many married men, single men, women and families.

Often asylum seekers have fled from genocide, war, persecution or other situations of forced migration. The Family Forge recognises the human rights of all individuals and seeks to assist every person that passes through the centre to travel 'From Fear to Confidence' in all ways. The Family Forge offers refugees and asylum seekers a place of welcome, friendship and support. But also the skills necessary to establish and flourish in their new home.

Specifically we offer this support through drop in services, culture and citizenship activities and a variety of classes.

Classes include streamed English language from beginners to advanced maths, online driving theory, online food safety, CV development, job hunting, culinary and family topics. This is all done free of charge.

How you can help

Decide to leave a legacy or make a donation.

Legacies are an important source of income for charities. Many people choose to leave gifts to charities.

Leaving a legacy involves making a will

Making a will ensures that your estate will go to the people you

want it to, your family, friends and good causes. You can write

your own will but it is best to get a solicitor to do it. If you wish to leave a legacy to the Family Forge, take this form with you. It

has the necessary contact details of the charity and registered charity number. If you already have a will and you wish to leave

a legacy to The Family Forge, simply add a sentence to your existing will. This addition is called a codicil, your solicitor can advise you on the wording to use.

Types of legacies

1: Pecuniary legacy - leaving a gift of money.

2: Residuary legacy – leaving any or a proportion of any undistributed assets under your will.

3: Specific legacy – leaving an item which is not money

Suggested Wording

We would strongly recommend that you have your will drafted by a solicitor to ensure your wishes are carried out properly but here are some examples of suggested wording you may like to use.
